

## **LEXINGTON NATIONAL INSURANCE CORPORATION PRIVACY POLICY**

We value you as a customer and we know how much privacy means to you. We will inform you of our policies for collecting, using, securing, and sharing customer information the first time we do business with you and every year you are a Lexington National Insurance Corporation customer. This privacy policy describes our privacy practices for both current and former customers.

### **I. How we collect information about you**

We collect personal information about you on applications or other forms you complete such as your name, address, Social Security Number, family member information, assets, income, property locations and values. We collect information, depending upon the type of bond you are requesting, from consumer reporting agencies, courts, and other sources.

### **II. How we share client information with affiliated and non-affiliated third parties**

We do not disclose any nonpublic personal information about our current or former customers to anyone except as permitted by law. Recipients of permitted disclosures include: government, regulatory and legal authorities in response to a subpoena, to prevent fraud, to comply with an inquiry by a government agency or regulator, or as necessary for other legal purposes.

We may also disclose all of the information we collect to nonaffiliates for the purpose of qualifying for bonding, which you have authorized, and for other purposes including, auditing, research, and marketing services. We may also disclose information to independent credit reporting agencies. We do not provide account or personal information to any company for the purpose of independent telemarketing or direct mail marketing or any products or services of those companies. Information may be disclosed to our licensed producers to enable them to assist in processing your bond transaction.

### **III. Our practices regarding information confidentiality and security**

We follow strict security standards and procedures intended to prevent unauthorized access to personal information. Only properly authorized employees may access information we collect from or about you to conduct Lexington National Insurance Corporation business. Employees who have access to customer or consumer information may use it only for legitimate business purposes. Additionally, we safeguard customer and consumer information in accordance with applicable data security regulations. Our licensed producers and employees are required to comply with these policies.

### **IV. Notice and explanation of opt-out provision**

We reserve the right to disclose nonpublic personal financial information about you to a nonaffiliated third party. You may opt out of that disclosure by contacting Lexington National Insurance Corporation at (888) 888-2245. In the case of joint consumers, each joint consumer may opt out separately but may opt out on behalf of all of the other joint consumers. Your choice to opt out would apply to any bond that you obtain from a licensed producer for Lexington National Insurance Corporation.

### **V. Modifications to our privacy policy**

We reserve the right to change this Privacy Policy without providing an advance notice of our intent to make the changes.
