

Privacy Notice
This Privacy Notice describes the privacy practices of
Lexington National Insurance Corporation

I. We Safeguard Information We Collect About You

We follow strict security standards and procedures intended to prevent unauthorized access to personal information. Only properly authorized employees may access information we collect from or about you to conduct Lexington National Insurance Corporation business. Employees who have access to customer or consumer information may use it only for legitimate business purposes. Additionally, we safeguard customer and consumer information in accordance with applicable data security regulations.

II. How We Collect Information About You

We collect personal information about you on applications or other forms you complete such as your name, address, Social Security Number, family member information, assets, income, property locations and values. We collect information about your transactions with us, through underwriting and claims inquiries during the normal process of policy administration. We collect information, depending upon the product or services you are requesting, from consumer reporting agencies, courts, and other sources.

III. Third Parties To Whom We May Disclose Information We Collect

We do not disclose any nonpublic personal information about our customers to anyone except as permitted by law. Permitted disclosures include; government, regulatory and legal authorities in response to a subpoena; to prevent fraud; to comply with an inquiry by a government agency or regulator; or as necessary for other legal purposes.

We may disclose all of the information we collect, as described above, about our customers to companies that perform services and functions, including marketing services, on our behalf.

IV. Confidential Medical Information

We do not share personal medical information that we might collect about you internally or externally for any purpose except the following:

- S Underwriting insurance;
- S Administrating your policy, account, or claim;
- S As required or permitted by law; or
- S As otherwise authorized by you.

This privacy statement describes our privacy practices for both current and former customers. We will provide one copy of this notice to joint or contract holders; please share this information with everyone covered by your policy or contract. Upon your request, we will send additional copies of this statement.

The term “you” refers to individual consumers who make application and customers who obtain insurance products, insurance services and/or financial services from us for personal, family or household purposes.

The term “personal information” means personally identifiable financial information that is not publicly available.

The term “personal medical information” means information that identifies you, is derived from a health care provider or from you, and relates to your physical, mental or behavioral health, to health care provided to you, or to payment for your health care.

We reserve the right to change our privacy policies and insurance information practices. If we make any material changes to our policies or practices, we will provide you with a copy of a revised notice.
